Aquoral is used to moisten and lubricate the mouth, tongue, and gums in treating patients with xerostomia (dry mouth). Dry mouth may be caused by disease, medication, chemo or radio therapy, stress, aging, or lifestyle factors. Aquoral should be sprayed directly into the mouth using the tongue to spread the product.

• **You should not take Aquoral if . . .**

You have sensitivity or are allergic to corn oil, silicon dioxide, aspartame, or artificial flavorings (citrus).

• **Warning**

Avoid contact with your eyes. Flush your eyes with water if you accidentally get Aquoral in your eyes.

• **Side Effects**

There are no known side effects when using this product.

• **What I Should Know About Taking Aquoral with Other Medication . . .**

Aquoral is not known to interfere with other medications. Regardless, tell your healthcare provider if you are taking Aquoral or other medications so that he/she is fully aware.

Always talk to your healthcare provider before starting any new medications.
